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1. Analysis Concerning Results of Operations and Financial Condition

(1) Analysis Concerning Results of Operations

Future-related items mentioned in this document are based on the information available at our corporate group as of the last day of the current quarter of the consolidated accounting period, and include uncertain contents. Please keep in mind that they may be different from actual results.

(1) Performance situation

In the second quarter of the current consolidated fiscal year, the Japanese economy saw the deceleration of business results and a slump in the stock market due to the advancing appreciation of the yen, and both corporate profits and consumer spending were weak. In addition, despite the fact that the situation is gradually returning to normal after the Kumamoto Earthquake in mid-April, there are worries for the future of the global economy due to the UK's withdrawal from the EU and the deceleration of emerging nations' economies, including China, and the uncertain situation is still continuing.

Amid this business environment, our corporate group has carried out sales activities, etc. actively based on our business strategies in each segment. In addition, we made efforts to improve the added values of our services, by planning and implementing various measures for boosting synergetic effects among Nursing Care, Karaoke, and Restaurant Businesses.

As a result, sales of the second quarter of the current consolidated fiscal year were 12,135,802 thousand yen (up 3.5% Year-on-Year (YoY)), operating income was 216,194 thousand yen (up 182.1% YoY), and ordinary income was 350,085 thousand yen (up 118.3% YoY). In the second quarter of the previous consolidated fiscal year, there was an extraordinary income of 557,283 thousand yen from the sale and leaseback of one paid elderly nursing home, and proceeds on sale of noncurrent assets, including karaoke equipment and land. However, as there was no extraordinary income in the second quarter of the current consolidated fiscal year, profit attributable to owners of patent decreased by 235,882 thousand yen to 209,449 thousand yen (down 53.0% YoY).

The results of each segment were as follows.

1) Nursing Care Business

For the Nursing Care Business segment, three new "Sawayaka Ai-no-ie" day service centers for after school support for children with disabilities were established, and our corporate group established its first office, "Home Nursing Station Yahata" in September. Accordingly, the number of sales footholds as of the end of the second quarter is 75 (141 offices). At existing facilities, we aimed to stabilize occupancy ratio and reduce the number of vacant rooms by promoting the cementing of cooperation with nearby hospitals and home care support offices by visiting them. We also announced that we would welcome elderly victims of the Kumamoto Earthquake, which occurred in mid April, free of charge, and a total of 38 victims moved into our facilities. As a result, sales were 7,039,309 thousand yen (up 13.2% YoY) and segment income was 509,545 thousand yen (up 91.0% YoY).

2) Karaoke Business

For the Karaoke Business segment, we strived to increase customers for all-you-can-drink courses, etc. and mobile-service members for smartphones, to increase repeat customers, and utilized the informative websites for restaurants actively, to attract customers. However, in the wake of the Kumamoto Earthquake in April, 3 restaurants in Kumamoto Prefecture were closed for about 1 week, and customers in the entire Kyushu region decreased. As a result, sales were 4,002,710 thousand yen (down 5.1% YoY) and segment income was 249,870 thousand yen (down 17.5% YoY). In the second quarter of the current consolidated fiscal year, we did not open any new stores, but closed one store. Accordingly, the number of stores is 96 as of the end of this quarter.

3) Restaurant Business

For the Restaurant Business segment, 2 restaurants changed its business type. Also, 1 restaurant was opened and 3 restaurants were closed down. Consequently, the number of restaurants as of the end of the second quarter is 23 in Japan,

and 3 outside Japan. As for existing restaurants, customers were decreasing, and so we strived to increase them with a limited offer, and made efforts to meet the demand for banquets, etc. by visiting each enterprise, to increase corporate customers. However, one restaurant was closed for about 1 week due to the Kumamoto Earthquake, like the Karaoke Business, and the number of customers was on a decline. As a result, sales were 882,344 thousand yen (down 6.7% YoY) and segment loss was 33,369 thousand yen (segment loss was 46,873 thousand yen during the same term last year).

4) Real Estate Business

For the Real Estate Business segment, our corporate group's core businesses activities are sales/purchase of real estate properties for sale and intermediary work for rental properties. As a result, sales were 100,138 thousand yen (down 53.3% YoY) and segment income was 26,857 thousand yen (down 56.8% YoY).

5) Other businesses

In the Other businesses segment, mainly in the hotel business, the company made efforts to increase guests, secure bookings for parties, promote day trips for bathing, etc. However, in April the business was greatly affected by the Kumamoto Earthquake, and the number of guests decreased. As a result, sales were 111,299 thousand yen (down 16.2% YoY) and segment loss was 14,381 thousand yen (segment loss was 1,125 thousand yen during the same term last year).

(2) Analysis Concerning Financial Situation

1) Status of assets, liabilities and net assets

Total assets as of the end of the second quarter of this consolidated fiscal year came to 30,480,988 thousand yen, down 431,420 thousand yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year.

Current assets came to 13,161,856 thousand yen, down 937,059 thousand yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This is mainly because cash and deposit and current assets (other) decreased.

Noncurrent assets came to 17,319,131 thousand yen, up 505,638 thousand yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This is mainly because buildings and structures, land, and property, plant and equipment (other) increased.

Liabilities as of the end of the second quarter of this consolidated fiscal year came to 15,442,282 thousand yen, down 184,371 thousand yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year.

Current liabilities came to 6,091,040 thousand yen, down 341,487 thousand yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This is mainly because notes and accounts payable-trade, short-term loans payable, and current portion of long-term loans payable decreased.

Noncurrent liabilities came to 9,351,242 thousand yen, down 157,116 thousand yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This is mainly because long-term loans payable increased and noncurrent liabilities (other) decreased.

Net assets as of the end of the second quarter of this consolidated fiscal year came to 15,038,705 thousand yen, down 247,049 thousand yen from the end of the previous consolidated fiscal year. This is mainly because retained earnings arising from profit attributable to owners of parent and treasury stock increased.

Consequently, the equity ratio as of the end of the second quarter of this consolidated fiscal year was 49.3%.

As for the liquidity of funds, the current ratio as of the end of the second quarter of this consolidated fiscal year was 216.1%. We will boost this ratio, in order to secure sufficient liquidity.

2) Situation of cash flow

Cash and cash equivalent (hereinafter referred to as "funds") during the end of the second quarter of the current consolidated fiscal year stood at 8,542,558 thousand yen, down 758,782 thousand yen from the previous consolidated fiscal year.

The status of each cash flow is as follows:

(Cash flow from operating activities)

Funds obtained by operating activities were 575,696 thousand yen (funds obtained in the same period of the previous year

were 641,725 thousand yen). The major breakdown of income was 337,445 thousand yen of net income before income taxes, 575,071 thousand yen of depreciation and amortization. The major breakdown of expenditure was 271,461 thousand yen of increase in inventories and 108,231 thousand yen of increase in notes and accounts receivable-trade.

(Cash flow from investing activities)

Funds used in investing activities were 1,267,848 thousand yen (funds obtained in the same period of the previous year were 123,345 thousand yen). The major breakdown of expenditure was 1,018,019 thousand yen of purchase of property, plant and equipment and 172,662 thousand yen of payments of loans receivable.

(Cash flow from financing activities)

Funds used in financing activities were 61,021 thousand yen (funds used in the same period of the previous year were 1,206,037 thousand yen). The major breakdown of income was 1,620,000 thousand yen of proceeds from long-term loans payable and 229,251 thousand yen of proceeds from trust account for purchase of treasury stock. The major breakdown of expenditure was 1,293,447 thousand yen of repayment of long-term loans payable, 304,727 thousand yen of repayments of installment payables and 194,400 thousand yen of decrease in short-term loans payable.
